Dress Code

Females:

ALL ATTIRE MUST BE BLACK
Must wear tights to ALL Classes!

Acro: Leotard or bike leotard, stirrups, footless or convertible tights. Hair is to be secured in a braid, ponytail or bun.

Ballet/Pointe: Black leotard, pink footed tights and split sole pink ballet slippers. Black or pink shrugs, etc. are permitted in winter months while warming up. No socks and NO jewelry (except for small earrings). Hair must be slicked back and secured in a bun. Color code for All Competitive Classes is black leotard, suntan tights and pink ballet slippers.

Jazz: Leotard and jazz pants/ capris. Dance tank tops are permitted. Split sole jazz shoes or jazz tennis shoes. Convertible tights, so dancers are capable of warming up barefoot. Hair is to be secured in a braid, ponytail or bun.

Tap: Same as Jazz. Tap shoes of good quality. Check with Jacqueline on the type for your class. A dance T-shirt may be worn.

CWS I: Leotard, tights, tap shoes and ballet slippers. Hair pulled back.

Males:

Ballet: Black or White T-shirt, black jazz pants and black ballet slippers.

All Other Classes: T-shirt, workout pants and proper shoes.

REMEMBER: Proper fit shoes are required for all classes. Students cannot successfully execute steps in shoes that do not fit correctly.

Fundraising:

Funds may be used towards tuition, costumes, competitions, dance wear or pictures. All unused funds will not be carried over to the following year. If you do not return to class, the funds will be turned over to the general fund. 10% of the fundraising goes to the studio fee. Classes must be paid in full in order to use fund towards other payments.

Funds are not carried over to the next dance season.



Costume Info:

Costume & Finale deposits of \$50 per class, solo, duo & trio are due on or before October 2nd with balance due November 6th. Costumes are non-returnable and non-refundable. Costumes will not be ordered without FULL payment.
